It has been estimated in the average household not using a bidet, family members use 7~10 sheets of toilet paper per sitting. Paper is expensive to buy and also uses up considerable natural resources in its manufacture. The

production process is also reliant on bleaching agents and other polluting chemicals. Manufacturing and distribution both adversely affect carbon emissions. With an electronic bidet the need for toilet paper is at the least vastly reduced if not eliminated
